The use of "we" two paragraphs previous is not unintentional. There are three club members who have held vital behind-the-curtain roles in the last several years. Most important, Dick, AK1A, has provided the tools to do the typesetting, and has spent uncountable hours on the exacting task of adding the necessary markup information to the raw text in order to achieve the desired result. The latter chore was especially challenging for the many charts and tables which appeared in the Scuttlebutt and the YCCC Contest Handbook. John, K1AR, and Everett, AJ1I assumed responsibility for finishing the pasteup with page numbers and so

forth, and arranging for printing, collating, stapling, folding, labeling and mailing - another timeconsuming yet unavoidable element of producing your newsletter. Many other members have perceived the pressures and offered assistance. Unhappily, there appeared to me to be no way to integrate the efforts of additional personnel without increasing the period between issues, simply due to delays in communications. Coax-Seal Alternatives

Coax-Seal is a relatively new product on the amateur market, intended for weather-proofing coaxial connectors, etc. Its advantage over standard electrician's putty (also called duct putty) is that it adheres well to the plastic jacket of coax cables. The disadvantage is price. A small roll (5 foot by 1 inch wide) of the stuff costs 40 cents per foot The same material (I think) is now being sold to homeowners as an do-all sealer under various names such as "Miracle Seal." The cost is much lower, probably due to different packaging. A 15 foot roll 2 1/2 inch wide works out to 28 cents a foot, and 8 inch wide rolls get you down to 19 cents per foot. VFO-230 RFI

I recently had a problem that might interest others who own the Kenwood VFO-230. It began with occasional reports of distorted transmit audio, sometimes to the point where I was unreadable, especially on 10 meters. The audio sounded normal in the monitor mode on my TS-830S.

I found that problem occurred only with the beam pointing towards the shack - a good clue that RF was getting back into the rig somewhere. The problem was there even when transceive on the main VFO, unless the VFO-230 was completely disconnected from the TS-830S. Disconnecting the VFO-230 eliminated the trouble. I found that the mating surfaces of the VFO-230 top and bottom covers were painted, as well as the surface on the rear where it screwed to the rear panel. Scraping the paint from these surfaces resolved the problem.


